2006 Carneros Syrah

Tasting Notes: This wine is a blend of two well-known syrah vineyards (White Hawk in Santa Barbara and Las Madres in Carneros) and we've added in a small percentage of petite sirah from Eaglepoint Ranch (located in Mendocino). Each vineyard adds specific characteristics, depth and interest to this wine: Las Madres provides mineral, earthy and meaty notes; White Hawk adds deep rich blueberry fruit flavors, spice, black pepper and acidity); Eaglepoint Ranch provides concentrated deep fruit, acidity, deep color and structure).

The wine is a medium-to-full bodied syrah with a dark ruby/purple color, good structure, acidity, layering and balance. It is accessible now but should age nicely over the next 5+ years.

Vinification: Small lot, hand picked. Cold soaked 5 days (100% whole berries). Fermented separately in small, closed top stainless steel tanks. Pressed at dryness and aged separately in French Oak (medium toast +) for 20 months. Unfined and unfiltered, blended and bottled.

Alcohol: 14.2%
