2006 Cabernet Sauvignon – Napa Valley

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*Wine Spectator = 90 pts (May, 2009)*

*Aromas of loamy earth, currant and mocha-laced oak are full bodied and intense. Still chewy, tight and compact, yet this is a wine of substance, depth and persistence. Needs time. Best from 2010 through 2017. 75 cases made. JL*

Winemaker Notes: This is a “classic” Napa Valley cabernet sauvignon sourced from vineyards with great pedigree. 100% cabernet sauvignon, this wine is a blend of fruit from three premium lots and captures the essence and expression of the three vineyards (and three different AVA’s) it is sourced from - Inkgrade Vineyard located in eastern Napa Valley on Howell Mountain, To-Kalon Vineyard on the valley floor in Oakville and Trailside Vineyard located in Rutherford.

A very balanced wine with rich, deep fruit, wonderful layering and a hint of valley dust. It offers-up mountain fruit aromatics of black currants, blackberries, cedar and tobacco. Built to age and nicely structured with integrated tannins, approachable now but will continue to gain complexity as it matures. Decanting recommended in its youth.

Vinification: Small lot, hand picked. Cold soaked (75% crushed/25% whole berries). Fermented separately in small, closed top stainless steel tanks. Pressed at dryness and aged separately in French Oak for 22 months. Unfined and unfiltered, blended and bottled.

Alcohol: 14.8%
