2007 Syrah – Alder Springs Vineyard

Tasting Notes: Our 2007 syrah from Alder Springs Vineyard is a beautifully balanced and complex wine that is generous on the palate. The wine is polished, rich and persistent with a great depth of flavor. Baked blueberry pie, vanilla, spice and white pepper form the core of the palate. The finish is long with dark fruit and hints of mocha interwoven with sweet oaky tannins. Aromatics of blueberries, vanilla and caramel are generous on the nose.

Vineyard Info: Alder Springs Vineyard is one of the most prestigious and well-known syrah vineyards in Northern California. Located in Mendocino County, the vineyard is composed primarily of decomposing sandstone and elevations range from 1750 to 2700 feet. The vineyard averages approximately 1825 vines per acre.
