2007 Seventy Four – Forty One Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

**Tasting Notes:** Our 2007 Napa Valley cabernet sauvignon is a concentrated wine with deep intense color and structure. 100% cabernet sauvignon, the dark mountain fruits of black cherries and blackberries are complimented by hints of vanilla in the mouth– followed by lingering rich, oaky tannins. This wine will benefit from decanting in its youth and will continue to gain complexity with cellaring.

**Vineyard Info:** East of Calistoga, Ink Grade vineyard stands atop the Vaca Range on the eastern side of Howell Mountain and stretches across 200 acres of terraced mountainous terrain. The site, planted to a quad trellis, ekes out between 2 and 2.5 tons per acre. We blend in a small percentage of fruit from select valley floor vineyards to provide additional layering, complexity, depth and hints of valley “dust” in this wine.

**Aging:** 22 months in French oak (50% new)

**Alcohol:** 14.8%

**Bottling:** July 9, 2009

**Winemaker:** Kian Tavakoli

**Production:** 100 cases

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
